The Cornubia Miracle

Cornubia is a 'Human Settlement', a place where the government has built cheap housing for families living in shacks and slums. The first building went up in Cornubia 5 years ago. Immediately, Mark and Cookie began their outreach ministry to plant a church here. We worked with them in this area that will one day provide housing for 500,000 people. Finding property was not possible until God stepped

in and provided a miracle.



We were allowed to put up a temporary structure on a piece of land that they had no use for. Memorial fund monies from Max Ephraim and my mother Martha Pettenger were enough to build this church.
